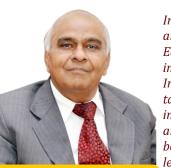

This campaign was officially launched by the Prime Minister, Narendra Modi on 145<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of the Mahatma Gandhi on 2<sup>nd</sup> of October 2014 at Rajghat, New Delhi.

The Pink City of Jaipur has a number of architectural wonders that attract tourists from all over the country & abroad. Most of the foreign tourists also tour this city of majestic forts and beautiful havelis. Therefore, a tour of Jaipur can at no time be called a dull affair. A stunning example of Mughal architecture blending with the Rajasthani styles, the City Palace is a museum that houses rare manuscripts, Mughal and Rajasthani miniature arts, weapons and other items used by the royal family members. Jantar Mantar, built in stone and marble, is the most extensive of the five observatories built by the warrior-astronomer Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh. It is a popular tourist attraction in Jaipur as it showcases India's scientific prowess in a time when us didn't exist. Amer Fort is the first on the list of many tourists on a sightseeing tour of the major tourist attractions in Jaipur. Set on a hilltop on the outskirts of Jaipur, it took nearly 2 centuries to complete this fort. Built by Raja Man Singh in the 16th century and completed by Sawai Jai Singh in the 18th century, the Amer Fort has several sites worth a visit.
